Kind Attention: All Recyclers under Battery Waste Management Rules, 2022

The Battery Waste Management Rules, 2022 have been notified by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India, vide Notification No. S.O. 3984(E) dated 22nd August, 2022.

Under the said Rules, recyclers are required to generate Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) Certificates through the Battery Waste EPR Portal (www.eprbattery.cpcb.gov.in). For successful generation of EPR Certificates, recyclers should maintain proper records of sales of recovered key battery metals and metal compounds, duly supported by GST-linked invoices.

In this regard, all recyclers are hereby informed that it shall be mandatory to upload GST e-invoices for the sale of recovered key battery metals/metal compounds on the Battery Waste EPR Portal with effect from 01.07.2026.

Further, all recyclers who do not have arrangements for GST e-invoicing are directed to obtain registration and comply with GST e-invoicing requirements immediately. It is hereby clarified that EPR Certificates generated on the basis of sales invoices other than GST e-invoices shall not be considered after 30.06.2026.

Any EPR Certificates generated based on non-GST e-invoices beyond the stipulated date shall be considered as false certificates and non-compliance under the Battery Waste Management Rules, 2022.

This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority, CPCB.
